

BONA CLEANER

Bona Cleaner is a highly concentrated, slightly alkaline cleaner specifically designed for the cleaning of finished wood and cork floors. Bona Cleaner can be used for regular mopping or in a machine based cleaning programme.

Preparations

Remove loose dust / grit etc. using a vacuum cleaner, scissor mop or other dry cleaning method.

Application

Dilute the concentrate as required for the condition of the floor. Clean the floor using a mop or an auto scrubber equipped with a white or tan pad. N.B. excessive use of water may damage the floor. Always keep the amount of water used to clean to a minimum and be careful where the floor has open gaps. When using a standard mop replace the cleaning water periodically to avoid streaking.

Auto-scrubber

- 1. Always fill the tank with clean water prior to use.
- 2. Run the machine along, never across, strip / plank floors.
- 3. Water should be removed promptly; do not leave puddles when turning with the machine. N.B. Water loss must not exceed 1 Lt / 100 m^2
- 4. If distributing water with the machine, remove the water within 3 minutes.
- 5. Do not clean timber flooring using brushes. Cleaning pads should be used. Do not use aggressive pads as they may scratch and wear the surface.
