Preparation

Sand and prepare the floor using accepted methods and finish to approximately 120 grit. Stir Bona DriFast Sealer thoroughly before use. Optimal application conditions are 18 – 25°C and 40 – 60% RH. Higher temperatures and lower humidity will shorten drying times. Lower temperatures and higher humidity will lengthen drying times. Minimum temperature for use is 13°C.

Application

Apply Bona DriFast Sealer using a brush or 5mm roller. A uniform timber saturation and maintenance of a 'wet edge' will avoid colour variation.

When dry, DriFast Sealer MUST be abraded thoroughly and evenly using a Bona Scrad pad or a worn 220 grit screen. Move lightly across floor to avoid sanding through the sealer film. Remove all sanding dust and apply 2 coats of Bona water-based top coat.

Additional Information

Very dense timber species such as Ironbark may be difficult to coat using Bona DriFast Sealer as penetration into the timber is minimal in the heartwood sections. A Bona water-based primer is a good alternative.

Natural oils found in and around knots in Cypress Pine may interfere with the drying process.

Bona DriFast Sealer should not be used as a final treatment for timber floors and should always be abraded prior to over-coating with a Bona water-based finish.

As DriFast Sealer contains drying oils, any cloths or rags should be placed in water or a sealed metal container due to the risk of self-ignition.
